This charity fundraiser will take place at Council Rock South High School in Holland, PA. We are happy to announce that the charity for this year's event will be **"BEAT THE STREETS of Philadelphia"**.

Beat the Streets Wrestling Program of Philadelphia (BTS) is a non-profit organization that is committed to developing youth wrestling programs in the Philadelphia area. The organization fosters the holistic support of student-athletes by providing resources for youth athletic wrestling programs together with academic mentoring in under funded local schools and community programs.

BTS is currently working with the Wissahickon Charter School (WCS) to initiate its wrestling program for the 2009-2010 academic year. WCS is the third wrestling program that BTS has been privileged to assist. BTS looks forward to expanding its efforts in the coming years to provide athletic and educational opportunities for student athletes across the Philadelphia region. All proceeds from "Wrestle 4 Relief V" will go directly to Beat the Streets of Philadelphia.

Our inaugural "Wrestle 4 Relief" event took place in October of 2005 with the proceeds going to the Red Cross in support of the Hurricane Katrina relief effort. "Wrestle 4 Relief II" benefited Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation to help fight childhood cancer. In 2007 it was Autism Awareness and the NeighborHeart Program, and last year, the D'Angelo Foundation. In all, the "Wrestle 4 Relief" tournaments have raised over \$17,000 for these charities. YOU are making a difference. "I know that this may sound like a cliché, but this wrestling community is indeed a family! This community transcends sports and competition. The true goodness of people and all that is right with the sport of wrestling and these kids has been on display during our Wrestle for Relief events as hundreds of wrestlers, coaches, parents and fans competed and donated their time and effort, all in the name of charity," said Brad Silimperi, Club Director of Team Apache and Head Wrestling Coach at Council Rock South High School. "I can tell you that the wrestling community is one that I am proud to be a part of."
